NOTICE TO THE FIRST YEAR STUDENTS

FEES CLEARANCE AND END OF SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

I hope this email finds you well as we come to the end of the **eleventh (11th)** week of September-December 2023 Semester. The examinations are scheduled to commence on **Thursday, 30th November, 2023**.

During your admission in September, 2023, the Government gave a directive that all first year students to be admitted as we awaited the categorization of students based on the New Funding Model. This process is now complete and the upkeep finances has already been credited to your accounts. The University has also been advised in which band every student has been categorized.

This is therefore to advise the following:

1. That the total amount you have been allocated as scholarship and loan is the Government support for the whole academic year and the balance is supposed to be catered for by the household (parents/guardians).
2. You will therefore be expected to top up the balance in two instalments; the first one to be cleared by next week and the other instalment will be cleared when you report for January-April 2024 Semester. The amount will be dictated by the band you have been categorized in.

It is also important to note that a student in:

- (i) Band 1 was allocated 70% scholarship and 25% loan and shall pay 5% from household
- (ii) Band 2 was allocated 60% scholarship and 30% loan and shall pay 10% from household
- (iii) Band 3 was allocated 50% scholarship and 30% loan and shall pay 20% from household
- (iv) Band 4 was allocated 40% scholarship and 30% loan and shall pay 30% from household
- (v) Band 5 was allocated 30% scholarship and 40% loan and shall pay 40% from household

For simplicity, in the case of BSc in Nursing, the above bands may be interpreted as follows:

In order to sit for the end of December 2023 Semester Examinations, the students will be expected to pay the amount in the last column (I) as per their category (column B).

Kindly liaise with your parents/guardians and ask them to clear the balances by next week **Thursday, 23rd November, 2023.**

For the students who did not apply or have not been allocated any funds, please arrange to pay up all the pending first Semester fees.


Students who do not fall under the 2023 New Funding Model **BUT** reported for their First Year of study in September 2023 should clear the fees as per the fees structure which was provided to them during the admission.

Kindly **NOTE THAT** no student will be allowed into the Examination room without having cleared all the requisite fees. Examination Cards will be ready for issuance from **Thursday, 23rd November, 2023.**
