STATEMENT ON ALLEGED DeKUT STUDENT ARRESTED FOR ROBBERY

The University would like to correct erroneous information that was published in an article in the Nation Newspaper on Wednesday, 1st September 2021 on the arrest of suspected armed robbers who raided the home of the Assistant Inspector of Police, Kingori Mwangi.

In the article, one of the robbers was identified as a third (3rd) year student of Dedan Kimathi University of Technology. However, on further investigation by the police and also by the University it was established that the suspect had given false information claiming to be a student of the University.

The University would therefore like to state that this person does not exist in our records as a student and that it is unfortunate that this erroneous information was published without verification. Further, the University takes pride in the tradition of discipline among its students and would therefore wish that the good reputation of our students is not tarnished though such false information.
